



Judgment of the USC Appeals Board in the matter of:

LIVERight v. USC Clubs Governance Committee, 2015:6

Judgment Date: October 11, 2015

Reasons for Judgment: The Board

1. The Board finds that the USC Clubs Governance Committee's decision to de-ratify LIVERight was both in accordance with the 2013 USC Clubs Operating Policy and was reasonable. S. 4.01(11) of the policy states that clubs must "maintain a membership of at least twenty-five (25) members, not including the Executive." The uncontested evidence presented before this Board indicated that the club had less than twenty-five (25) members when the decision was made. Nothing in this Board's decision precludes LIVERight from making a new application for ratification in accordance with USC by-laws.

DISPOSITON SUMMARY:

The appeal is dismissed
