The VAC will be required to provide weekly updates to the Curator and Creative Director, and be willing to take appropriate direction from members of the executive team.

Spoken Art Coordinator (1 position available): the SAC will work alongside the Curator and the Creative Director to secure any and all spoken art to be performed during the Nuit Violette exhibit. The SAC will be responsible for liaising with student groups and individuals to secure: spoken word poetry, short stories, short dramatic performances (in multiple languages, where possible), Indigenous story-telling, and other appropriate mediums. The VAC will be required to provide weekly updates to the Curator and Creative Director, and be willing to take appropriate direction from members of the executive team.

Musical Art Coordinator (1 available position): the MAC will work alongside the Curator and the Creative Director to secure any and all musical art to be performed during the Nuit Violette exhibit. The MAC will be responsible for liaising with student groups and individuals to secure: classical music, contemporary music, live music, recorded music, synthesized sounds, and other appropriate mediums. The MAC will be required to provide weekly updates to the Curator and Creative Director, and be willing to take appropriate direction from members of the executive team.
