Musical Art Coordinator:

 To secure musical forms of art for display; to work alongside the Public Arts Coordinator establishing exciting exhibits of musical art; to explore an array of auditory mediums for display, including but not

- limited to: classical music, synthesized sounds contemporary music, live music and recorded music.
- Organize events and exhibits pertaining to the musical arts and other relatable forms alongside the Public Arts Coordinator and to act as a curator for these events.

• Promotions/communications
