Whereas the USC and Western do not have any authority over the operations and governance of Greek Life organizations;

Whereas USC Councillors and the student body have expressed discomfort over the USC's continued relationship with Greek Life organizations;

Be it resolved that the USC begin the process of cutting ties with Greek Life organizations by no longer offering space and room booking at a subsidized rate; (passes 83%/10%/8%)

Be it further resolved that the USC not involve itself in fraternities' Rush Week programming henceforth. (passes 76%/17%/7%)

Be it further resolved that the Council Composition Procedure Section 3B be amended to remove Section V, which allows the Presidents of the Inter-Fraternity Council and Panhellenic Council Presidents to hold a resource member seat at Council. **(fails 37%/41%/22%)**

Be It Resolved that the USC President present a report to Council in January evaluating the effectiveness of the provision of GBV Resources to Greek Life organizations. (passes 98%/0/2%)
