2022 House Olympics Rules and Eligibility

- 1. All team members must be Western students.
- 2. All teams must submit their application by Feb 8th, 11:59 PM to be considered
 - a. Submit the application form on the including:
 - i. Team captain
 - ii. Team members' names
 - iii. UWO emails
 - iv. Student numbers
 - v. Address of student house
 - b. Post a TikTok with the hashtag #2022HouseOlympics including:
 - i. Team name
 - ii. Team member intros
 - iii. Team uniforms
 - iv. Why you are going to win (be creative!)
 - c. A select number of teams will be chosen to move forward to the qualifying round where students will vote for the Top 16 teams who will then compete in a bracket competition. If your team is not selected, your house is not eligible to compete.
 - d. Teams can find the application form and all information on the House Olympics page <u>here</u>.
- 3. All federal, provincial, and campus Covid-19 protocols and regulations must be followed.
- 4. All House Olympics teams must be composed of members in the same household in which the competitors live, and this household must be based in London, Ontario.
- 5. USC elections candidates cannot compete in House Olympics.
 - a. If a team member decides to run in an USC election, their team is still eligible to compete, however, the team member must leave the team and cannot appear in any content related to House Olympics.
- A House Olympics team cannot endorse or promote USC Elections candidates or their campaign content on their team social media accounts.
 - a. Team members are free to post campaign content on their personal social media accounts and are also eligible to be on a campaign team.
- 7. USC Staff, Board, Council, and paid volunteers are ineligible to complete.

- a. If a competing team's housemate is a USC Staff, Board, Council member or is a paid volunteer, their house is still eligible to compete, however, the student cannot appear in any content related to House Olympics.
- b. Housemates of the organizers and USC Executive are ineligible to compete.
- 8. Teams must be able to claim any prizes at the USC office in the University Community Centre in London, Ontario after the conclusion of House Olympics.
- Students cannot use any personal financial resources to purchase sponsorships or paid promotion for their team. All engagement should be a result of the team's personal outreach, and uplifting content should be a result of goodwill and should not be transactional.
- 10. The competing Team Captains or a proxy must attend the weekly meetings for updates and important information regarding the competition. If issues or changes to the program arise, they will be communicated at these meetings.
