- Thrive in front of crowds, but can also interact one-on-one with students
- Attend in person USC events when required
- Work under the creative direction of the Manager, Communications with support from members of the Communication team.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- The Goose Mascot must be an undergraduate or professional student as defined by Western University during the school year they are in this role.
- The Goose Mascot cannot hold another USC paid position, USC Councillor position, or Director position on the USC Board of Directors.
