Student Services Budget Redistribution

Whereas Student Services is a new portfolio this year and will differ in support needs from previous configurations of portfolios

Whereas \$18,000 was allocated in the budget for Coordinators that were not hired due to added full-time staff support and the changes made to the Clubs System

Whereas Food Support Services, Grants and Recognition, and Early Outreach are all under funded areas of the Student Services portfolio

Be it resolved that Council approve the reallocation of \$18,000 from the unhired Governance Coordinator and Clubs Policy Coordinator

Be it further resolved that Council approve the allocation of the funding to be \$2000 for Grants and Recognition, \$7000 for EarlyOutreach, and \$9000 for Food Support Services



Al Policy Recommendations

Whereas The USC does not currently have a stance regarding AI integration at Western;
