Whereas, federal advocacy remains an important part of the USC's advocacy strategy.

Whereas, membership in a strong federal advocacy organization facilitates that strategy.

**Whereas**, the CASA report as written by the VP External Affairs recommends that the USC join CASA.

**BIRT** the USC council approve the following referendum question:

Should the USC join the Canadian Alliance of Student Associations at the cost of \$2.44 per full-time student, subject to an annual increase by CPI?

**BIFRT** the USC take the affirmative side and run a campaign on the affirmative.

### Motion to Establish Student Rental Experience Working Group (SREWG)

**Whereas,** Canada is in the midst of an unprecedented housing crisis, which has prompted the USC to explore ways to improve the student housing experience at Western

**Whereas**, the overwhelming majority of upper-year students at Western rent off-campus housing

**Whereas,** a group of Ivey students, under the name of the "Student Rental Experience Project" (SREP) desires to collaborate with the USC in the form of a Working Group in order to help facilitate tenants' rights education and protection for student renters

**BIRT** Council create a Student Rental Experience Working Group (SRWEG) and approve its Terms of Reference as attached, with the purpose of "identifying challenges students experience while renting housing and developing solutions to combat those challenges"

#### Motion 6

#### Interfraternity & Panhellenic Council Relations

**Whereas**, Fraternity and Sorority organizations represent over 1,000 undergraduate students on Western campus and are not being represented as a student group by the USC; and,

**Whereas**, the USC wishes to adopt an approach of restorative justice in its relationship with fraternities; and,

**Whereas**, both the Panhellenic Council and the Interfraternity Council have expressed an interest in re-integrating into the USC Community; and,

**Whereas**, both Councils have provided written commitments to actively engage in anti-gender based violence education, as well as their policies and processes for addressing gender based violence should it occur;

**Be it resolved that,** the Interfraternity Council be provided with access and resources to gender based violence prevention education, access to USC spaces at no cost, and access to bookings on Concrete Beach,

**Be it further resolved that,** the Panhellenic Council be provided with access and resources to gender based violence prevention education, Sororities access to USC spaces at no cost for meetings, philanthropy and recruitment events, and access to bookings on Concrete Beach'

Be it further resolved that the USC commits to ongoing dialogue with both Councils,

**Be it further resolved that** all three parties agree to ongoing monitoring and evaluation of the relationship in the spirit of restorative justice, and

**Be it further resolved that** both organizations remain independent of each other, but remain in constant collaboration with each other as outlined.
