Revision of Grants Policies and Procedures

Whereas: The current grants policies and procedures have been identified as confusing and unclear for students to understand, potentially hindering their ability to apply for and receive grants effectively.

Whereas: The lack of clarity in the current system has led to delays in the grants committee's ability to respond to applications in a timely manner, potentially impacting student and club activities on campus.

Be it resolved that: The USC adopt the revised grants policies and procedures as developed through the recent review process, which aim to streamline the application process and improve clarity for students.

Be it further resolved that: The VP Student Services and the Grants and Recognition Coordinator implement these new policies effective immediately, and conduct ongoing assessments to ensure the changes effectively address the identified issues and align with the USC's mission of providing better support for clubs and students on campus.

University Budget Submission Recommendations
