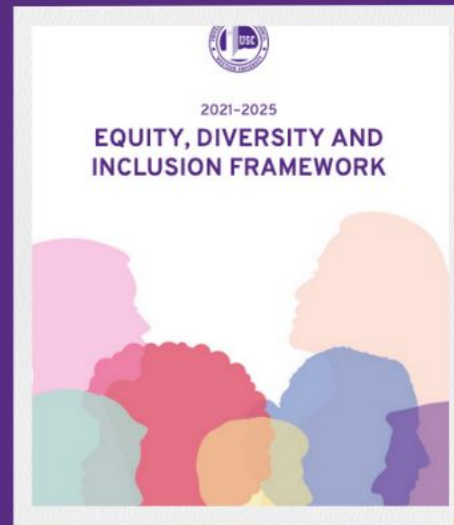
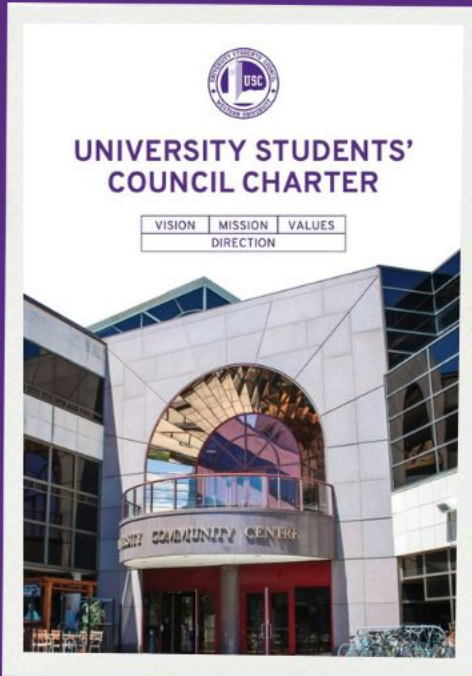

A **students' union**, also known by many other names,^[note 1] is a [student organization](#) present in many [colleges](#), [universities](#), and [high schools](#). In [higher education](#), the students' union is often accorded its own building on the [campus](#), dedicated to [social](#), organizational activities, representation, and academic support of the membership.

In the United States, *student union* often only refers to a physical [building](#) owned by the university with the purpose of providing services for students without a governing body. This building is also referred to as a [student activity center](#), although the [Association of College Unions International](#) (largely US-based) has hundreds of campus organizational members. Outside the US, *student union* and *students' union* more often refer to a representative body, as distinct from a *student activity centre* building.

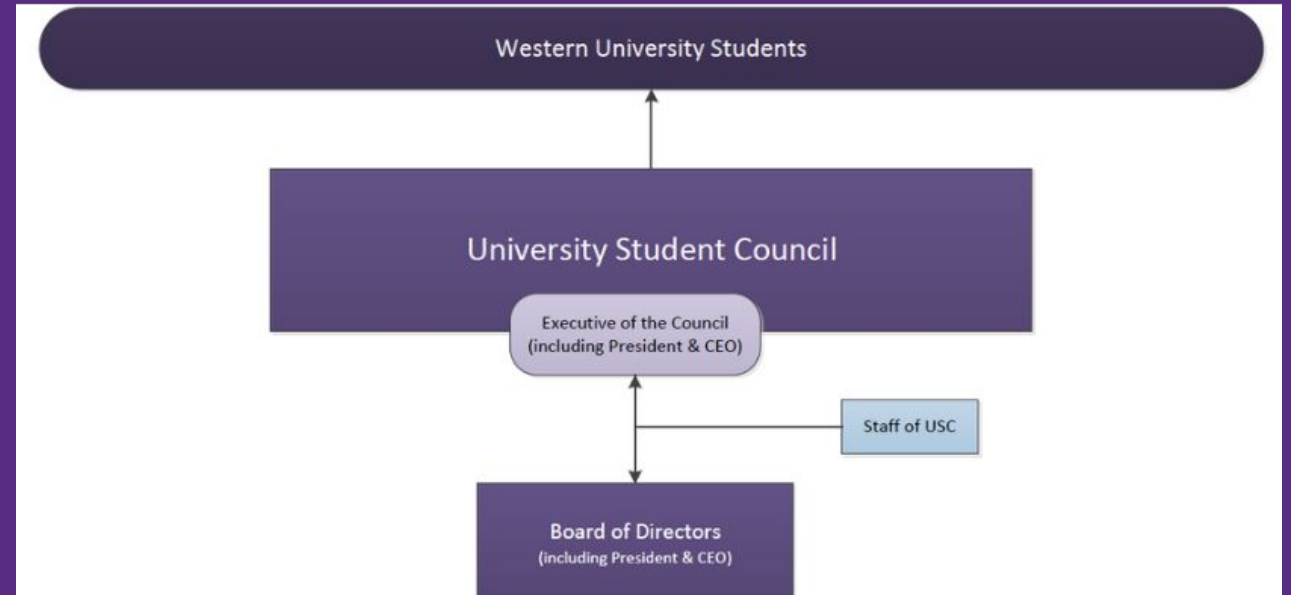

USC Governing Bodies

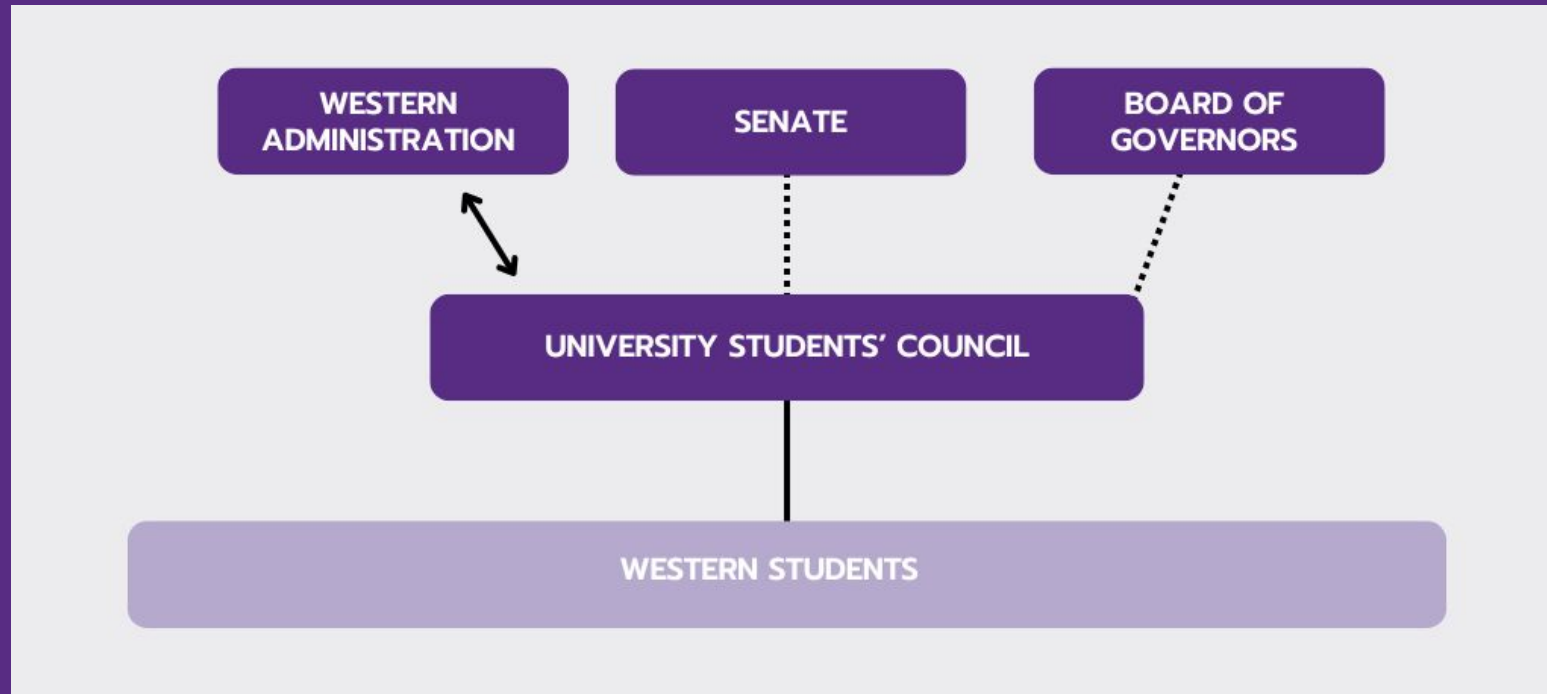
The **USC Executive** run student events, support services, and advocacy for the students of Western University with their portfolios of hired and volunteer student staff.

The **Board of Directors** govern the corporate side of the organization, with the COO as their sole employee.

The **Council** is similar to Members of Parliament at the federal level, Councillors are the USC's legislative body. Council is separate from the Student Executive but an equal partner in how the USC is run. It is made up by elected student representatives.

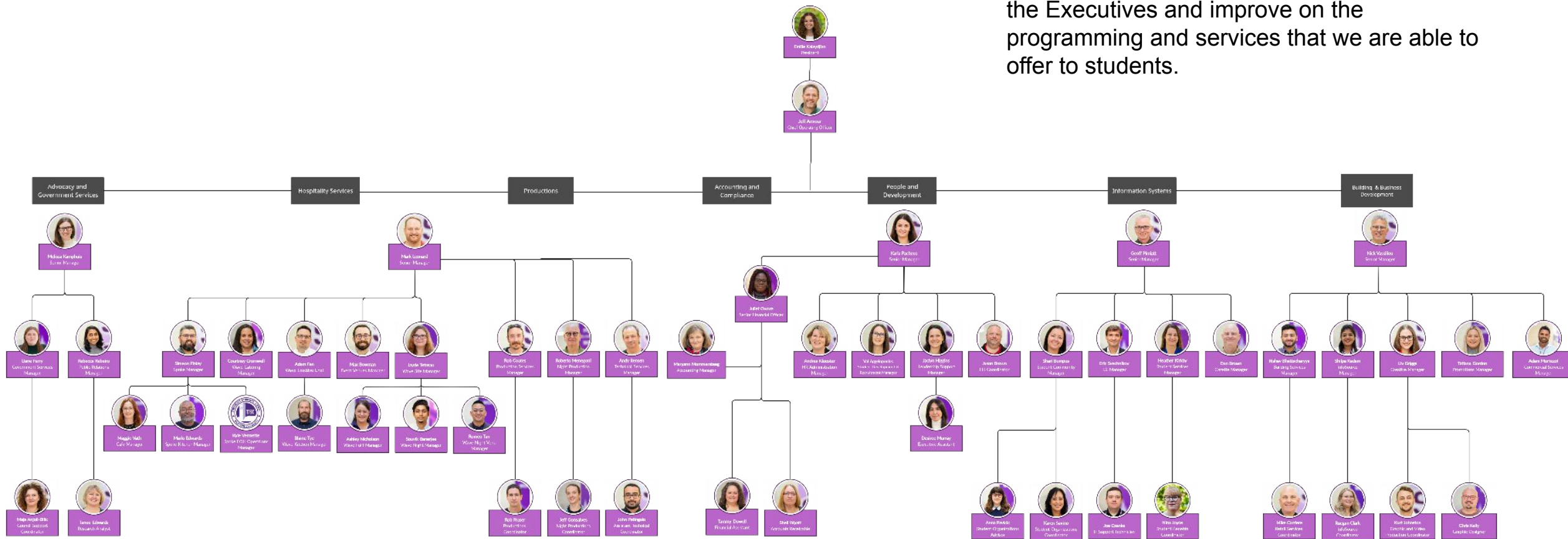


University Ecosystem



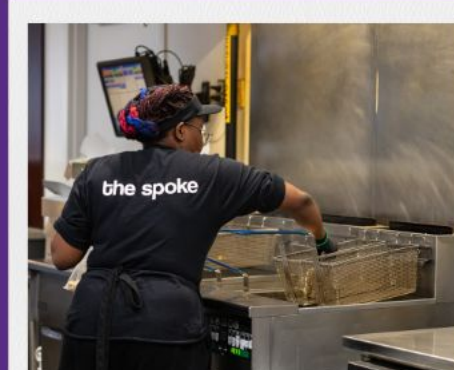
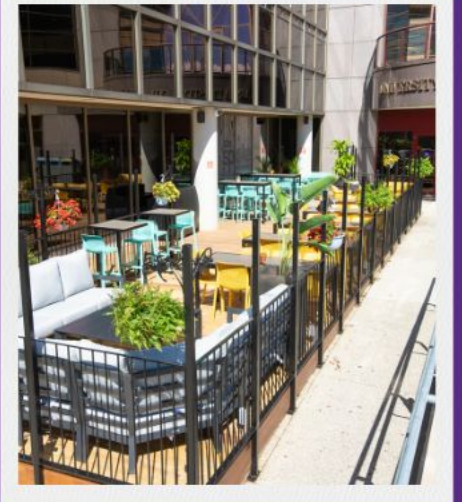
